RESOURCE CENTER

Once again we are approaching the beginning of a new school year hence the list of necessary items your child will need to start his or her school year will soon be coming. Depending on the size of your family and the number of children you have to help with supplies, this time of year can be somewhat stressful. I would like to offer up some suggestions on some community resources that may be able to assist in providing some of the school supplies your child may need. Keep in mind that due to the large number of families requesting this assistance the supplies get depleted very quickly. It is advised that you contact the community agencies as early as possible. The Jeffco Action Center located at 8755 West 14th Avenue in Lakewood puts together packets of school supplies every year. Their office is located on the corner of 14th Avenue and Colfax. Their telephone number is (303) 237-7704. Every school year The Bridge Church puts together some backpacks filled with school supplies for students in need. Again, supplies are limited so please let your child's counselor know of their need at registration.

CALCULATORS

Students require calculators for ALL math classes at BCHS. All students are required to complete courses through Algebra II. You may want to consider higher level requirements when investing in a calculator.

Algebra I & Geometry

A scientific calculator with trig functions sin, cos, and tan (approximately \$10.00).

Geometry Honors and higher

A graphing calculator such as the TI-83 Plus, T-84 Plus or TI Inspire (approximately \$100.00).

Graphing Calculators are available for rent from the school at a cost of \$25.00 per year, for students enrolled in Algebra II or higher. The fee is walved for students on free and reduced lunch.



<u>2022 – 23 Online Registration and Schedule Release</u>

Bear Creek HS will be utilizing an online process and in person process for releasing student schedules and fees payment for the 2022-23 school year.

Parents can and are encouraged to update their information digitally in Infinite Campus. Students will be allowed to pick-up their schedules at the following times if all necessary information has been updated. During these times parents will be able to receive help with Enroll Jeffco information (required), register for free and reduce lunches (this applies to activity, athletic, and other school fees), and pay fees/fines. Students will also be able to get their lockers and sign up for athletics/activities as well as pickup their schedule. School administration and counselors will be available to help with these responsibilities.

August 1st - Online fees payment system opens

Schedule change policy:

Students can request a schedule change on these days for the following reasons:

- Placed in the wrong level or level change needed
- Do not meet the prerequisite or failed the prerequisite
- Already took and received credit for the class
- Need more classes to meet graduation requirements
- Change or drop an AP or Honors class
- Warren Tech scheduling issue

Student ID pictures, additional locker assignments and parking passes will all be done during the first full week of school. You can begin the **parking pass process** by going to the Bear Creek website under the Students section and filling out the Google form.

FREE AND REDUCED MEALS

Some families may qualify for free meals or for reduced-price meals. Families can apply for meal benefits online or by submitting a paper application. Online applications are the *fastest and easiest* way to be approved for meal benefits, but paper applications are available below or at every school.

Families must reapply for free or reduced-price meals every year on or after July 1st.

Online Applications:

- Families apply online through SchoolCafe
- First-time users will need to create an account
- Instructions for creating an account and submitting an application are available both below in the **Additional Resources** OR online at www.jeffcoschoolfood.org

Paper Applications:

- Paper applications are available in English, Spanish, Russian and Vietnamese. .
- Remember, applications may take up to 10 business days for processing from the time they are received by FNS.

SCHOOL MEAL UPDATE

As we recently communicated, the federal school meal waivers will no longer be available for the 2022-23 school year. This means a return to paid meals beginning August 16 for students who do not qualify for Free or Reduced Meals benefits.

What's Next for Families?

- Meals will no longer be free. They will be charged based on Free, Reduced, and Paid Meal eligibility. Money
 can be added to student accounts using School Cafe, www.schoolcafe.com/JeffcoSD.
- Families need to complete a <u>free and reduced meal application</u> on School Café. Completing an application is one of the ways to be considered eligible for free or reduced price meals. **Applications opened July 1 so please take action.**
 - Log in to School Café or set up a new School Café account by <u>viewing these instructions</u> (you will need an account, and may not complete an application as a "Guest").
 - o Complete your free and reduced meal application.
 - While online applications are preferred, paper applications are also available (July 1 and after) at your student's school or the Food & Nutrition Services Office located at 809 Quail St., Building 1, Lakewood.
 - Families who are enrolled in SNAP, TANF, the Migrant Education Program, or other qualifying assistance program might be directly certified for free meals in Jeffco. This information is automatically transferred to Jeffco Public Schools for school meal eligibility.
- Families not eligible for free and reduced lunch will begin paying for meals using their school café account or pay cash.
 - o If your student gets a school meal, the account will be charged. The school does not deny a student a meal. You can set up your student's school meal account through School Café.
 - Meal prices will cost the following:

Elementary Breakfast: \$2.00
Secondary Breakfast: \$2.25
Elementary Lunch: \$3.25
Secondary Lunch: \$3.50
Adult Lunch: \$4.25

■ Milk Only: \$1.00

What Will Meal Service Look Like in 2022-23?

- Students will come through the line and eat in the cafeteria.
- Students will use their PIN (Student ID Number) when receiving meals and a la carte items.
- Please make sure your student knows his/her Student ID Number.
- Menus will be posted on www.SchoolCafe.com.
- On School Café, you may also place restrictions on your student's account regarding what they may purchase as a la carte and/or how frequently they may do so.
- Product and labor shortages may continue to affect menu items and availability.

Benefits of Completing an Application:

- Schools receive important funding and resources based on the number of free and reduced applications.
- School fee reductions
 - While fee waivers or reductions in fees will vary from school to school, the following fees can be waived or reduced, based on Free and Reduced Lunch eligibility:
