



Why TechforEd (1:1)?

- 1:1 means individual students receive a district-owned device for their learning
- Prepares students to thrive in a connected, digital world in alignment with the Jeffco Generations strategic plan
- Creates an equitable and sustainable model for technologyenabled classrooms



Expectations:

- Come to class prepared to learn
- Take care of your device
- Do not share your login & password information
- Report issues with your device right away
- If you unenroll from Jeffco Public Schools, return the device to your school; if your school is closed, take it to the Ed Center receptionist (1829 Denver West Drive, #27, Golden, 80401).



Care Tips:

- Keep device in its protective cover
- Charge device fully each night on a hard surface
- Clean device screen with microfiber or anti-static cloth
- Protect device from extreme temperatures, food & drinks, small children & pets



Safety & Security:

- Student information is kept private
 - Complies with all laws about student privacy and personally identifiable information
- Web filtering using Securly
 - Works at school and at home

Repairs & Accidental Warranty Options

- Repairs done by Lenovo certified technicians
- Families are responsible for damage to the device
- Purchase a warranty to cover non-warranty damages to your device. Two options available: Basic (1 repair per year) and Full (unlimited repairs per year).
 - o Basic coverage for 4 years = \$50.44
 - Full coverage for 4 years = \$86.32
- Typical non-warranty damages and their repair costs:
 - o Touch screen replacement = \$100.00
 - Keyboard replacement = \$50.00



Troubleshooting:

- Restart device
- Confirm device is connected to the Internet
- See website for additional troubleshooting tips
- Take device to your teacher or school library for repair



Lost or Stolen Devices:

- All district TechForEd devices contain an asset tag with a phone number that will help us recover lost/stolen devices
- Once the device is reported lost/stolen to the school, we will disable usage of the device
- Additionally, lost/stolen devices will display a disabled/locked screen with return to Jeffco instructions
